INVITATION

Timing: January to October 31st 2022

RULES OF COMPETITION

Competition will be decided by the results of:

Target, Freestyle, and Standard Crossbow Shooters:

1 x BPR600/70 Round comprising 60 competition bolts at 70m on full-sized World Archery/FITA licensed 40 cm multi-coloured target face for Target, Standard, and Freestyle crossbows.

Medieval Crossbow shooters:

1 x BPR600/50 comprising 60 competition shots at 50 m on a full-sized World Archery/FITA licenced single 40 cm multi-coloured target face.

Any shooter who is concerned about bolt damage may opt to shoot a World Archery/FITA licensed 40 cm three spot (Vegas or triangular arrangement) or vertical strip multi-coloured 5 zone face.

There will be both Individual and Teams competition for Target, Standard and Freestyle Sport and Medieval crossbows. Each Federation may enter up to four (4) MIXED teams (combined male and female). Each team will comprise three (3) shooters with all shooters in a team using the same type of equipment regardless of age or sex. Teams do not have to be announced before shooting has been completed.

Rounds should preferably be shot in conjunction with a National, Regional, or major championship shot under WCSA Shooting Rules. Such competitions must be registered WCSA STAR EVENTS, must be registered prior to the start of competition, and shall be listed on the WCSA shooting calendar. A copy of the registration form is attached.

Entry is open to all WCSA affiliated federations and clubs covering both the Target, Freestyle, and Standard and Medieval crossbow divisions for Men, Women, Senior categories, Juniors (Under 18 years), and Assisted categories.

Scoring:

The double scoring system must be used. This means that there must be a shooter's version and a witness version of each score sheet for each round. These must be retained by the Federation as scanned data.

You must use Score Sheet 5, published "Full Indoor Score Card" on the "Competition and Shooting Rules" page of the WCSA web site.

We are aware that there electronic scoring systems available, but at present we do not have a single universal system. Therefore, paper score sheets must be used.

Payment of Entry Fee:

\$ AUD 30.00 per shooter for each bow type.

Awards: Gold, silver and bronze WCSA medals in each class for both Individual and Mixed Team competition. WCSA Star badges may be claimed via your federation Secretary.

If entry levels are high enough awards will be made for Male, Female, etc. in the Medieval class.

Making an Entry:

PLEASE READ THIS CAREFULLY

Entries may only be made by a member Federation. Where a country does not have a Federation, an individual may make their own entry provided the correct shooting conditions are met.

Before a tournament takes place send a Tournament registration form to the Secretary General.

An Entry must include:

- 1. Individual Entry Form (check that every field is correct)
- 2. Team Entry Form (check that every field is correct)
- 3. Shooter's score sheet for every individual (check that every field is correct)
- 4. Witness score sheet for each individual (check that every field is correct)

If the "Senior box" is ticked we will assume 55+. For Senior 70+ add 70+ in Senior box on the score sheets and the Individual Entry Form.

All information to be sent electronically as pdf files.

Do Not send any entries until all shooting has been completed and verified by the Federation.

Do Not send any entries before 1st October 2022.

Entries must set by e-mail to reach the organiser not later than 31st October 2022.

Entry fees must be sent to the Finance Director not later than 31st October 2022.
