WCSA Judge Accreditation

- WCSA Judge Committee is responsible for accreditation of both International Judges and International Judge Candidates.
- Accreditation period is 4 years (from the end of a World Target Championships to the end of the World Target Championships 4 years later.
- The first time of accreditation (passing the exams) will last until the relevant World Target Championships.

WCSA Judge Accreditation

Requirements:

- Applicant must be an accredited national judge for a minimum 2 years
- Applicant must have served in at least 1 other major tournament sanctioned by WCSA with a positive evaluation of the Chairman of Judges.
- The applicant's Member Association needs to sign the application form.
- The applicant must attend a WCSA Judges Seminar and pass a written exam.
- The applicant will then be considered as a "International Judge Candidate".

WCSA Judge Re-accreditation

Requirements:

- Documented judge activity at a minimum national level during the accreditation period.
- Making themselves available for at least one international duty every two years.
- Completing and returning the re-accreditation form to the Officials Director within the deadline.

WCSA Judge Candidate Upgrade

To be upgraded from an International Judge Candidate to an International Judge the following must be met:

- Officiate at an international event (includes Regional Championships).
- Have a satisfactory evaluation report by the Chairman of Judges.
