WCSA logo competition

In response to member feedback, the WCSA Executive Committee is currently looking to upgrade the design and quality of medals for World and Regional Championships. This is also a good time to review our logo, particularly since we are now developing Sport and Medieval crossbow shooting. While the current logo has served us well, the current logo depicts Target shooting only and is difficult to reproduce. Consequently, the Executive Committee has decided to conduct a competition to develop a new logo. The requirements are that:

- The design is representative of all crossbow types;
- The design is easily and readily identifiable with WCSA;
- Is readily re-produceable in both colour and black & white and in small sizes (including small badges/pins). Minimum number of colours preferred; and,
- Is suitable to use on new WCSA championship medals.

Designs are invited from anyone and should preferably be in electronic format (such as JPEG). It would also be useful to include a brief explanation of the design in the case of highly stylised logos.

Applications close with the Secretary General on 28 February 2010. All entries shall remain the property of WCSA and the Executive Committee may or may not use any design.

A suitable prize will be awarded to those designs considered suitable. The award of prizes shall be at the sole discretion of the Executive Committee.

3rd World Indoor Postal Championships, January-September 2010

Due to popular demand, the 3rd World Indoor Postal Championships will be held between January and September 2010. This is an easy way for federations to participate in a World Championship without having the high costs of international travel. National federations can register their Indoor Star events which must be conducted between 1 January and 30 September 2010 under WCSA rules. Entry forms, standard scoresheets are available on the website.

Federation calendars and registration of WCSA Star events

Member federations are reminded that it is time to register your 2010 calendar of events and in particular those events which you want registered as WCSA Star events for the purposes of claiming WCSA Star achievement badges. Your Star events will be placed on the consolidated WCSA Calendar.

WCSA Achievement Awards – WCSA Star badges

WCSA achievement awards (WCSA Star badges) are available for purchase by member federations for the TC 900 and SC600 outdoor Target and TC600/25 and TC600/40 Indoor rounds. Purchasing details are available on the WCSA website. The responsibility for administering the award of badges rests with member federations. Members are reminded that WCSA Star badges may only be awarded for scores shot in registered WCSA Star events as included on the WCSA shooting calendar.

Membership fees, contact details and communication

Members are reminded that 2010 membership fees are due and payable on 1 January 2010. Membership renewal invoices have been sent out shortly under separate cover.

Communication is vital for our sport to grow. Members are requested to advise their contact details. Many e-mail addresses are not valid.

The WCSA website has been recently upgraded and there will be further improvements in the future. Thanks to our webmaster Stephen Sommers.
