2nd European Target Crossbow Championships, Ennigerloh, Germany

The 2nd European Target Crossbow Championships will be held in Ennigerloh Germany from 6th to 8th June 2014. This will be a target only open to Target, Sport & Medieval crossbows and will be held simultaneously with an IAU German Masters Championship. There may be an unofficial short-form Matchplay completion at the end of the second day's shooting.

It is possible that there may be informal talks between WCSA and IAU in Ennigerloh.

1st World Postal Benchrest/Prone Championships

Events will include Target, Martchplay, Forest Field, 3D, Bench/prone, Clout, novelty and money shoots. This event is sanctioned by both the WCSA and the IAU.

Crossbow activity in India

Due to a series of most regrettable incidents, the WCSA Executive Committee was obliged to expel the Crossbow Shooting Association of India on 12 December 2013, together with President Anil KAUSHIK. Mr. Kaushik then formed a new organisation called World Crossbow Association. Members and others are advised not to have any dealings whatsoever with the CSAI, World Crossbow Association or Mr. Kaushik. The matter has also been brought to the attention of the IAU. Mr. Kaushik continues to make problems and confusion in India and beyond.

As a consequence of this, the 1st Asian Crossbow Championships which were scheduled to be held in Ghaziabad in February 2014 were cancelled.

WCSA has been working tirelessly with Mr. Rajat VIJ with a view to establishing a new national federation in India to be known as thye Indian Crossbow Shooting Association. The ICSA will be formed in conjunction with the Indian Open Crossbow Championships to be held in Agra, on 15 and 16 February 2014. A WCSA Judges' Course will be conducted in Agra by Chairman of Judges Stephen Sommers and International Judge Tony McLoughlin on 14 February 2014.

WCSA has appointed Mr. Rajat Vij as Asian Development Officer.
