Gift policy

It is normal practice for shooters and officials at World and Regional Championships to give token gifts to other shooters and officials.

All gifts shall be small, such as stickers, badges and similar items, and should be no bigger than a cap.

All gifts shall be small and light in weight. Large and bulky objects are inappropriate given that the recipients need to carry them home.

There shall be no formal ceremonies for gift giving. All gifts should be given informally on a one-to-one basis.

The value of all gifts should be of a nominal/low amount, no more than the cost of a cap, for example.
