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GUIDELINES FOR SCORING AND AWARDS

January 2026

Purpose.

These guidelines have been compiled to provide additional information for all World Crossbow Shooting Association (WCSA) crossbow members and should be read in conjunction with the current WCSA – Shooting Rules.

The WCSA – Shooting Rules and these Guidelines refer specifically to All Registered WCSA events.

Scoring.

WCSA have a series of Standard Scorecards for Target, Indoor, Matchplay and Forest/Bushland which are available on the WCSA website. It is recommended that the appropriate scorecards be used for every event regardless of it being a Registered Championship or Club shoot. Regularly using the WCSA standard scorecards will ensure that all shooters are aware of the layout of the scorecards and all information required to be entered on the scorecards.

For major events the Organising Committee may insert the Event Name and Event Logo onto the scorecard (if applicable). The Organising committee may also fill in some preliminary information for the shooter and this should always be checked to ensure it is correct.

It is very important that you as the shooter, fill out all the information required on the scorecard/s. The Rating number for your score is optional and will be checked and added by the WCSA Recorder. If you are interested in the Rating for Rounds, refer to the “WCSA Star Event and Rating Policy” on the WCSA website at www.worldcrossbow.com/Competition&ShootingRules.html.

Required Information: (refer Correct and Incorrect scorecards in Appendix 1 and 2)

Your scorecard details (Appendix 1):

Surname, Given Name, Round, Country, Target Number, Date, Crossbow Type, Gender and Class.

Your scoring details (Appendix 1):

Distances to be shot, Bolt scores, Bolt end score, Progressive score.
Score Rating (will be entered by the Recorder when processing).

If an incorrect bolt score is accidentally entered then a Judge MUST be called to adjudicate, then the Judge will change the entry and sign the scorecard in **RED.**

Completing your scorecard (Appendix 2):

Distance Ring 10's, Distance All 10's and Distance Total Score, Total Hits, Total Ring 10's, Total All 10's, Total score.

Signature of the shooter, Signature of the Witness and any Award Claim/s you may have earned.

It is the responsibility of you, the shooter to check your scorecard/s before signing them. Having signed your scorecards, you have accepted the scorecards, and they cannot be altered in anyway after you sign your scorecard/s.

Any scorecards submitted for inclusion in an "Event Results List" and found to be missing any information, may be rejected and or discarded.

Award Claims.

The WCSA has available medals and awards for scores achieved at approved registered WCSA Championships. These include World Championship Records, World Records, Regional Championships, Regional Records, Team Records, Matchplay records and WCSA Star Badges.

Star Badges are available for purchase and details are available from the WCSA Recorder. (recorder@worldcrossbow.com)

All Record claims must be submitted to the WCSA Recorder with all documentation by email for processing. If this is not possible the claim maybe submitted by post. Contact the Recorder for postal details.

Any claim must be received by the WCSA Recorder within 60 working days of the event. Claims made after this period will not be processed.

All claims must include the following information.

Event Verification Form, Event Registration confirmation, both scorecards of the claiming competitor and the Event Results sheet. This information is to be scanned for submission via email to the WCSA Recorder.

Any claim made that does not include all of the above information may be returned to the sender for correction. The corrected claim must be received by the WCSA Recorder within seven (7) working days of the date of the return or may be rejected.
