STAR EVENTS POLICY.

PURPOSE.

WCSA Member Federations and WCSA Affiliated Clubs may register their outdoor and indoor tournaments as Star tournaments. Registered Star tournaments allow competitors to claim Star Badges, Records (if applicable) and Rating points for the World Ranking List. For information about Rating points see page 8.

World Star events can be conducted for Target and Indoor in the Target, Standard, Freestyle, and Medieval Crossbow divisions.

Matchplay scores are not eligible for Ratings or World Ranking.

Affiliated Individual members may conduct Star events provided they Register and Verify the event using the standard forms and have approval from WCSA. They must also comply with all conditions and rules as set out in this policy.

This policy does not apply to Forest, Bushland and 3D events.

WCSA approved World Championships and Regional Championships are automatically registered as Star Tournaments.

The rounds listed in [Appendix 3](#) may be registered as Star tournaments. These rounds may be used to claim Star awards and for the World Ratings List.

The following rounds are also eligible for WCSA World or Regional Record claims.

Outdoor rounds: (single and double)

- TC900/65/60 Target crossbow
- TC900/55/60 Target crossbow (Snr70+ / Junior)
- SC600/55/60 Standard crossbow
- FC600/55/60 Freestyle crossbow
- MC900/40/60 Medieval crossbow

Indoor rounds: (single and double)

- TC 600/18/40 All crossbow types

PROCEDURE FOR REGISTRATION.

1. Ensure all officials and competitors are familiar with the WCSA – Shooting Rules. The WCSA Shooting Rules are available on the WCSA website.
2. Select a round from the list of eligible rounds in Appendix 3.
3. Select a date on which the event will be conducted.
4. Select a suitable venue (Outdoor or Indoor) for the selected date and round. A World Star event held at multiple venues within a country at the same time will be regarded as one event.
5. Contact a local WCSA Official or Club official to officiate at the event. The WCSA Official and or the Club official must be familiar with the WCSA – Shooting Rules.
6. Complete the “Event Registration form” (Appendix 1) for the planned event.
7. Submit by email the completed “Event Registration Form” to the WCSA – Recorder at recorder@worldcrossbow.com and Webmaster at president@worldcrossbow.com.
8. Ensure you have received confirmation that the Event Registration Form has been received by the WCSA - Recorder before running the event.
9. The event will be added to the WCSA – Calendar on the WCSA website.
10. World Star events MUST be registered and approved prior to the start of any event.
11. Tournament Registrations for World Star events for the upcoming year should ideally be submitted in January annually for publication in the WCSA website Calendar.

FEES

12. The host Member Federation or Affiliated Club may set their own competitor entry fees for Star events as they see appropriate.
13. A host Member Federation or Affiliated Club may pre-order Star award badges using the Order Form (Appendix 6). The WCSA Recorder will advise pricing and availability. Payments from outside Australia to be in Australian dollars via the WCSA PayPal account to the Financial Officer.
14. The purchase price of the WCSA “Star Badges” for achieved scores will be set by the WCSA Executive from time to time. The WCSA Recorder will issue requested Star Badges following approval and payment confirmed by the Financial Officer.

HOSTING THE EVENT.

15. The host Federation or affiliated Club shall advertise the registered Star event and provide details to all interested parties.
16. Star events are “Open” events, and all WCSA registered members must be invited and welcome to compete.
17. If the host of the Star event needs to impose entry conditions due to venue size and capacity this must be noted on the Registration form and officially announced when the host calls for entries.

18. If entry conditions are imposed due to venue size, the available spaces will be filled based on "first come basis". The starting time of the event must be included at the time of registration and included in all public announcements promoting the event.
19. The host cannot restrict entry to a Star event based on Score, Ability, Experience, Crossbow type, Individual/Club/Federation membership.
20. The WCSA official and or Club official must ensure the venue has been set up in accordance with the WCSA – Shooting Rules.
21. The WCSA official or Club official must ensure that there are enough scoresheets for double scoring by each competitor. Electronic scoring is permitted in addition to a paper scorecard for each competitor.
22. The WCSA official or Club official must ensure that all the Target butts and target frames are at the correct distance and secured. The Target faces are in the correct position on the Target butt. The Target faces are the appropriate size and type for the round to be conducted.
23. For all Target Outdoor and Indoor events, ensure the Director of Shooting (DOS) is familiar with the WCSA Shooting Rules and the Timing for the round. Also, they are familiar with the timing system to be used at the event either manual or electronic.
24. There must be a minimum of 2 current WCSA registered shooters competing at the Star event. The nominated Official may be a competitor.
25. Multiple Star events may be registered in the same federation on the same date.
26. The Star event host will be responsible for all costs and expenses relating to the conduct of the event.
27. All shooting must be timed (electronic or manual), and timing must be in line with WCSA Shooting Rules.
28. All World Crossbow Shooting Rules must be always followed.
29. All Star events shall be double paper scoring using the WCSA standard scorecards available from the website. A combination of paper and electronic scoring is permitted.
30. The Event Official shall check all scorecards for the competitors' signatures, indicating that the competitor agrees with the value of each bolt, the total, the number of 10's and the number of Ring 10's.
31. Cancellation of Star events must be lodged with the WCSA at **recorder@worldcrossbow.com** even after the date the event was scheduled and cancelled. A reason for the cancellation must be advised at the time of lodging the cancellation.
32. Events cancelled due to poor or extreme weather conditions and circumstances beyond the control of the host may be rescheduled with a minimum of 5 days written notice to the WCSA at **recorder@worldcrossbow.com**.
33. It is the responsibility of the host to advertise and promote the Star event. WCSA will place the event on the WCSA website Calendar and any details concerning the event provided by the host.
34. The host may impose a reasonable fee to all competitors to cover costs and expenses related to the conduct of the event. How this is determined is at the discretion of the event host.

PROCEDURE FOLLOWING THE EVENT.

35. At the completion of the event, instruct all competitors and scorers to check and sign their paper scorecards and cross check with an electronic scorecard if applicable, then deliver the completed paper scorecards to the event officials for completion of required documentation.
36. Pack up all equipment and return the venue as required.
37. Host Federations and affiliated Clubs may pre-order Star badges from the WCSA recorder. This will allow competitors to claim the badges they achieved, at the completion of the event.

PROCEDURE FOR EVENT VERIFICATION BY OFFICIALS.

38. The event must be verified by the WCSA Official and or Club official who conducted the event in accordance with the WCSA Shooting Rules by completing the Verification form and check list ([Appendix 2](#)).
39. Review all scorecards to ensure they have been completed and signed by the scorer and the competitor as required. Signing a paper scoresheet means the competitor agrees with the electronic scoring when used.
40. Scan all completed documents – Results Sheets and Event Verification Form including any request for Records (copy of both scorecards required) and Star badges then email these documents to the WCSA – Recorder for processing of Star awards, records (if applicable) and rating points. The Verification documentation must be received by the WCSA Recorder within fourteen (14) days of the event so that Records and Ratings may be processed without delay.
41. The WCSA - Recorder will return and NOT process any documentation from an event if all the documentation is not complete and correct when submitted.
42. Any Event information received more than sixty (60) days after the original event date will not be processed.
43. After the verification documentation has been accepted, WCSA will publish the Results sheet on its web site.
44. Scores may be considered for a “Record Claim” but only if a WCSA Judge or federation / club official was officiating, and the event was conducted in line with WCSA Shooting Rules and that there must have been a minimum of 2 current WCSA registered shooters at the start of the Star event. For Record Claims both signed score sheets must be sent to the recorder with the Verification sheet and Results sheet for processing within 14 days after the event.

WORLD STAR AWARD BADGES.

45. WCSA Star Award Badges recognise the achievement of an arbalist at a WCSA Star event.
46. WCSA does not keep a register of Star badges that a competitor has received. Federations and Clubs may choose to create their own register to ensure competitors do not claim the same badge several times.
47. Arbalists may claim a Star badge by completing the relevant section on their score card. Federations and Clubs may award Star badges even if the arbalist has not marked their score card.
48. Achievement levels (Elite Gold, Elite, Grand master, Master and Gold) are as detailed in [Appendix 5](#) for Target, Standard, Freestyle and Medieval crossbow.

RATINGS POLICY.

PURPOSE

1. The World Target Rating Policy is intended to provide additional opportunities for and to encourage all arbalists to compete and submit scores through Registered Star Events published on the WCSA website.
2. The World Ranking List will provide arbalists with a comparison as to their standing amongst other arbalists around the world. The eligible round Scores, Ratings and the Ranking list may be used for Team selection, practice or training.
3. This policy does not apply to Forest, Bushland and 3D events.
4. Qualifying scores may be shot in any registered Target or Indoor tournament that complies with the World Crossbow Shooting Association (WCSA) Shooting Rules and the World Target Rating and Star Event Policy.
5. The World Ranking List is a combination of Target and Indoor results.

RATING CALCULATOR.

6. Eligible WCSA Star event scores will be compared with the WCSA Rating chart for that event. (refer [Appendix 5](#)) The achieved Rating number from the chart will be used by the WCSA Recorder to produce the WCSA - World Ranking lists.
7. A WCSA member must compete in at least one approved WCSA Star event to acquire a WCSA Rating and listed on the World Ranking List. Competing in any subsequent approved WCSA Star event will provide a number from the Rating chart for that event. This new Rating number will be compared to the competitors previous Rating number and if it exceeds the original Rating number by at least two (2) points. The original Rating number will be increased by half the difference creating a new updated Rating number. If the difference is less than two (2) points, then the original Rating number will be maintained unchanged.

Only whole numbers are permitted in the Rating system.

8. The Rating numbers will then be used to produce the current WCSA World Ranking Lists. On the 1st of January, 1st of April, 1st of July and the 1st of October each year, a new WCSA World Ranking list based on all members current Rating will be produced by the WCSA Recorder based on scores received and published on the WCSA Website.
9. All WCSA members' Ratings following the publication of a new Ranking list as per the dates listed above will be reduced by ten (10) Rating points. WCSA members will then be required to compete in a registered and approved Star event to update their Rating number prior to the next scheduled and published Ranking List.
10. Any WCSA member Rating number that has reduced to zero will not appear on the Ranking List until they have submitted a registered round score for a Rating number.

Calculation (Competitor B) - (81 minus 82 = minus 1) new rating (no change) = **82****Competitor C**
